

## Half Square Triangle Master Class

Supplies:
You can work from yardage or scraps.
Choose a variety of prints (or solids will work well too!) and a background fabric (this can also be a variety of fabrics.)
Look for good contrast between your prints and background fabrics.
From both a print (or solid) fabric and a background fabric, you'll need the following:
(2) 4 " squares - so (4) squares total: 2 prints and 2 backgrounds
(2) $53 / 4 "$ squares - (4) squares total
(4) 8 " squares - (8) squares total
(1) $4^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strip -2 strips total (these can be cut from fat quarters: 4 " $\times 21^{\prime \prime}$ )
(3) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips -6 strips total (these can be cut from fat quarters: $3^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ )
(1) $3^{11 / 2 "} \times$ wof strips -2 strips total (these can be cut from fat quarters: $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ )
(2) fat quarters each print and background for creative play!
