

Starting With Silk

SUPPLY LIST

- A small stash of silks; pieces of garments, neckties, silk scarves, small yardage of dupioni, taffeta, furnishing fabrics etc.
- Scraps or yardage of lightweight iron-on fusible interfacing. Good lightweight choices are Pellon's P44F, 906F and SF101 or Quilters Select Fabric Prep
- At least ¼ yd plain lightweight cotton muslin, pre-washed if possible.

- Small, unscented candle
- Pie tin or 12x12" piece of aluminum foil
- Matches/lighter

- Sewing machine, cord and pedal, bobbins
- Thread in a neutral color
- Scissors, thread snips and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade
- Cutting mat and ruler
- Iron and ironing surface
- Pins
- 1/2-inch presser foot or walking foot.
- Notebook/Sketchbook and pen/pencil
