## Modified Quilt as You Go Class

Think of this technique as two-step quilting. This class yields 25 perfect $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " quilted blocks embellished with a variety of applique options, then assembled. Quilting thru each block and batting individually makes quilting easy for both new and experienced quilters alike - no bulk or awkward struggling with a large sandwiched quilt. A great project for increasing accuracy, as well as small space quilting, like retreats, or for me, my RV! Add backing fabric and the second step quilting and you are done. This technique can be used to create any size quilt that can be appliqued in endless options. So much fun!


SUPPLY LIST
Fabric

- 25 - 5 inch squares. This will be your Background Fabric - it can be all the same or coordinated.
- Assorted Accent fabric scraps, approx. fat quarter's worth to contrast with your Background.
- $3 / 4$ yd any color Backing Fabric
- $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ Binding fabric (will NOT be needed for the class)
- $1 / 4$ yd Wonder Under Fusible Web *
- 25-4 inch squares of Fusible Batting* (* Wonder Under and Fusible Batting can be purchased from the instructor for \$5.00)

Other Essentials

- Sewing machine with zigzag stitch, $1 / 4$ inch foot, and open toe foot
- Parchment paper or Teflon pressing sheet
- Scissors, straight pins
- Ruler $-5^{\prime \prime}$ square or larger, and oblong $4 \times 14$ or bigger for squaring up rows
- Thread for piecing, quilting, and zigzag to contrast or match your background and accent fabric.
- Rotary cutter and small mat
- Paper and pencil for notes

Supply Charge - Optional if you don't want to bring your own - $\$ 5.00$ for Wonder Under and Fusible Batting

Classroom Needs

- Irons, ironing surfaces and cutting mats for students to share
- Table space for student sewing machines and sufficient electrical outlets
