

## Supply list for Sewing with Kids - #1: Pillow/Tooth Fairy Pillow

You can choose to do either a tooth fairy pillow (shown below) or just a regular 14-inch square pillow



### Supplies:

- 100 percent cotton fabric
  - Tooth Fairy Pillow:
    - White fabric for coloring, front and pocket on back (2 pieces of fabric 6" x 6" squares)
    - Print or solid color fabric, back (1 piece of fabric 6" x 6" square)
  - Pillow:
    - White fabric for coloring, front (1 piece of fabric 15" x 15" square)
    - Print or solid fabric, back (2 pieces of fabric 7 ½" x 15" rectangle)
- Freezer Paper
- Masking Tape – ½-inch blue painter's tape
- Crayons
- Tooth Fairy Pillow: Optional - I have some polyester batting that you can use to stuff the pillows. If you would like to use something else, bring your own filling.
- Pillow: 14" x 14" pillow insert
- Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies (thread, scissors, pins)
- Iron

### Before class:

#### Step 1:

Wash and dry the 100 percent cotton fabric. Do not use fabric softener or dryer sheets.

#### Step 2:

Iron the white fabric on to freezer paper.

Step 3:

Lay out the design of your choice using the masking tape.
